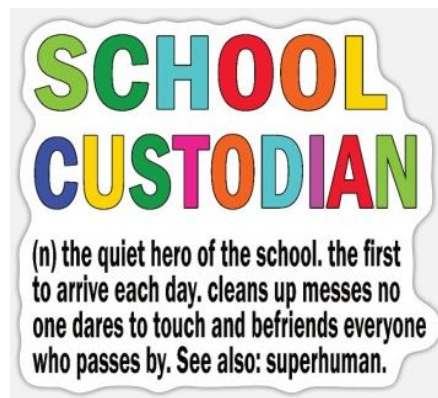
We are also looking to hire a **full-time Paraprofessional**. You will be able to apply for that position soon.
