## A word concerning sign outs...

I support the need to occasionally sign out your child due to appointments that can only be made during the school day, for family emergencies, or a sudden onset of illness during the school day. However, we have noticed a high number of students asking to sign out for much less critical issues. Sometimes the reason the parent/guardian gives does not match the reason the student gives. We have also had instances in which students sign out of the same class at the same time.

If your child feels ill during the school day, our nurse assistant will assess the situation as the first line of medical attention for your child. If a student leaves an item (homework, lunch, etc.) at home, we will work with the student so the student may remain at school. We will NEVER okay a sign out for a student to cross highway traffic to go to the Dollar General to buy medication, food, or other supplies, even at the parent/guardian's request.

We want your child to experience success at high levels at school. Having your student in school every day, all day, will help us reach that goal. We appreciate your cooperation.
